In continuation to this Office Order of even number dated 27.04.2021/11.05.2021/22.05.2021 on the above subject, please find enclosed herewith a copy of Office Order No.CSB-63(1)/2020-ES.I Vol.III dated 5th June, 2021 which is self explanatory.

The Government of Karnataka has issued revised guidelines in Order No.RD 158 TNR 2020 dated 3rd June, 2021 which will remain in force upto 06 am of 14th June, 2021 for strict implementation.

All the earlier instructions issued vide ibid Office Order dated 27th April, 2021 & 22nd May, 2021 shall continue with regard to closure of Offices of CSB / CSTRI in Karnataka State up to 06 AM of 14th June, 2021 and essential activities mentioned in ibid Office Order dated 27th April, 2021 regarding preventive measures to check the spread of the pandemic, attendance, vaccination of all Officials of CSB/CSTRI will continue.

Accordingly, the Officers/Officials working at CSTRI, Bangalore and its units located in Karnataka are advised not to leave their Headquarters during this phase, they should work from home and they should be available on Phone/Electronic Communication mode and seek instructions from superior offices if required to attend the office, in case of exigencies, officials may be required to attend Office by following COVID Appropriate Behaviour / Containment Zone restrictions etc.

In order to prepare for lifting of lock down & resumption of office, the Divisional & Sectional Heads of CSTRI and Head of its units located in Karnataka are advised to ensure that Video Conference/ Webinars / Online Meetings etc. are held in the ensuing the week so that urgent pending tasks are attended to. In order to prepare for the lifting of lock down & resumption of office, Divisional & Sectional Heads of Offices are advised to ensure that Video Conference/Webinars / Online Meetings are held in the ensuing week so that urgent pending tasks are attended to. A record of such work may be maintained by the officials. ORDER

Whereas, the State Executive Committee has issued revised guidelines to break the chain of COVID 19 transmission in the State, vide Order No. RD 158 TNR 2020, dated 07-05-2021 and further amendments to the said guidelines were issued vide Addendums 1 to 9. The State Executive Committee vide order of even number dated 21-05-2021 has further extended the implementation of the revised guidelines and related addendums upto 6 am of 07-06-2021.

And Whereas, the situation of COVID 19 in the State has been reviewed and it is observed that there has been reduction in the number of new cases and decline in positivity rate due to effective implementation of stringent containment measures. Further, the spread of COVID cases in semi-urban and rural areas are being steadily contained. However, the number of active cases in the State is still on the higher side, which is likely to decline in the near future with implementation of stringent containment measures.

And Whereas, after taking views of the health experts, the State is satisfied that to fully overcome the pandemic in the State it is imperative that existing containment strategy be continued for few more days before opening up activities in a phased manner.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under the Section 24 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the undersigned, in the capacity of the Chairman, State Executive Committee, **hereby directs that the guidelines to break the chain of COVID 19 transmission in the State issued vide order of even number dated 07-05-2021 and subsequent amendments issued to the**

guidelines vide Addendums 1 to 9 will remain in force including and upto 6 am of 14-06-2021, for strict implementation by Chief Commissioner BBMP, Police Commissioners, District Deputy Commissioners, Superintendents of Police, and other Heads of Departments and Authorities.

Furthermore, the following **additional activity** is permitted outside the containment zone **from 7/6/2021:**

- *All units/establishments which are directly engaged in exports are permitted to function with 30% of their staff strength strictly adhering to COVID appropriate behavior. Department of Commerce & Industries will notify the list of permitted Units/establishments. All such units which employ more than 1000 persons shall do COVID 19 test for at least 10% of the employees randomly twice a week.*

Separate SOP will be issued for Garments Exporting units.
